Theme: *The theme is the moral, lesson, meaning, or message you gathered or learned from this story. Write at least 2 sentences describing the theme.*

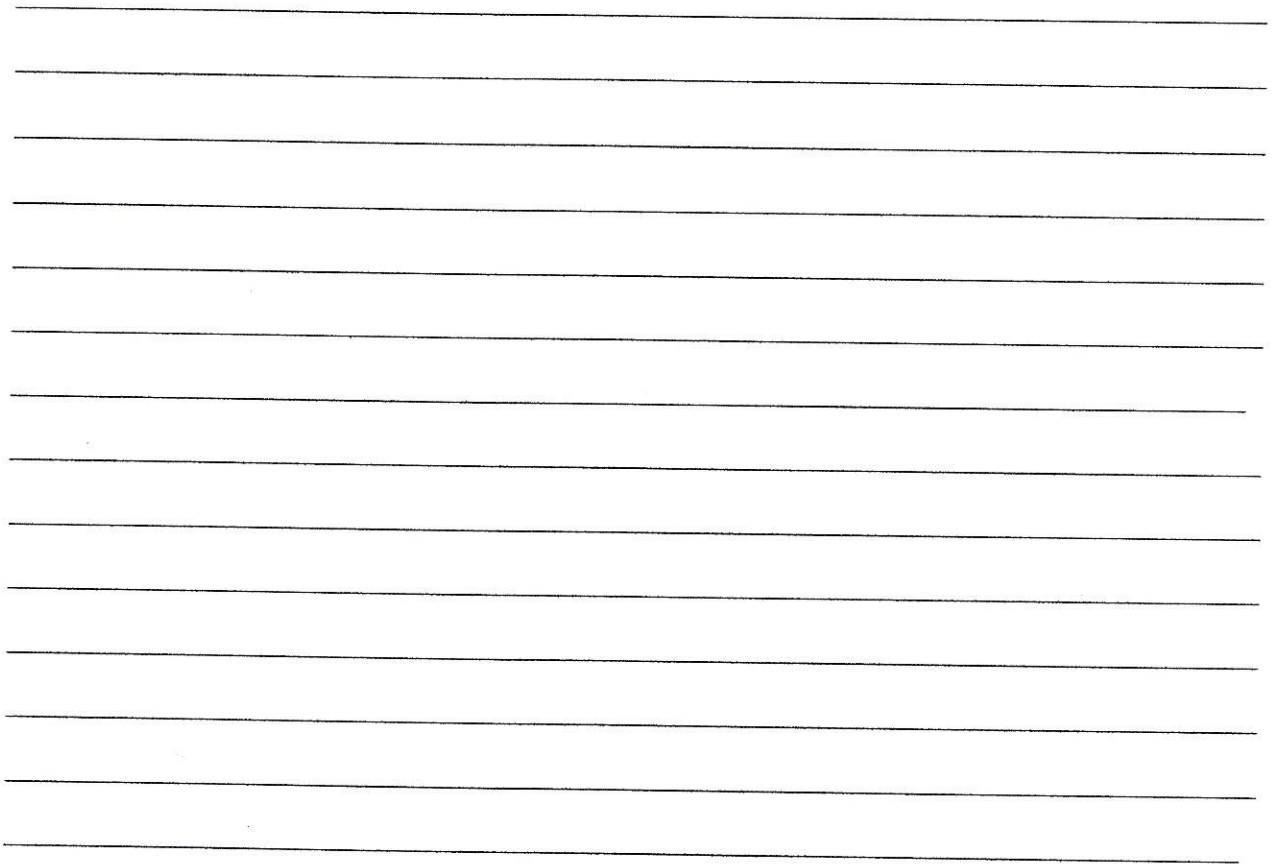
Plot: *What was the main event/s in the story? Write at least 3 sentences about the main event/events.*
